The Public Ministry of Archbishop John Walsh (1867 - 1898)


Wednesday, October 15, 2014 at 7:30 pm Father John Comiskey studied at St. Peter's Seminary and King's University College at Western University. He was ordained a priest in 1981 and later earned a licentiate and a doctorate in the history of the Catholic Church. In 1999 he joined St. Peter's Seminary as Assistant Professor of Church History and Patristics, as well as Registrar of Theology. He was named Vice-Rector two years later. In 2010, Fr. Comiskey was named pastor of Mary Immaculate Parish in London, but continues in his roles as professor and as Registrar of Theology. Father Comiskey's book titled *My Heart's Best Wishes for You: a Biography of Archbishop John Walsh* was published by McGill-Queen's University Press in 2012.
