Artwork: Johannes Vermeer, Christ in the House of Martha and Mary, ca. 1654-1656, National Gallery of Scotland



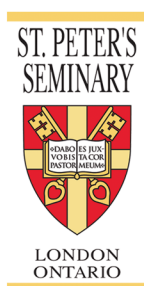
