



The 900-year-old Cross of San Damiano, as seen on the front cover, is a replica which hangs in the student common area of St. Peter's Seminary's new classrooms, which holds a central truth of Christian experience. The figure of the crucified Christ is surrounded by his Father and people - his Mother Mary, Mary Magdalene, apostles and saints, and two Roman soldiers who assisted in Jesus' death. They have one thing in common. All are witnesses to the Crucifixion. Indeed, our Church is a people who, like them, are witnesses to the Crucifixion and the Resurrection.

At the Seminary, we too witness the profound truth of the San Damiano cross, especially the formation of people to serve with faithfulness in ministry, and those who guide their growth in knowledge and enthusiasm for service.
