Seminary 5-Year Strategic Plan

St. Peter's Seminary has recently completed the development of a Strategic Plan which sets a course of action for the years 2015 to 2020. This has involved a collaborative effort involving: members of the Seminary



Board of Shareholders, Seminary Faculty, input given by the Seminary Working Committee (consisting of the Bishop of the Diocese of London, seminary staff members, business professionals with an acumen in financial planning, the Directors of the Seminary Foundation and Institute for Catholic Formation, parish priests and laity from the Diocese,) together with partners from our neighboring Catholic institution, King's University College, through which St. Peter's Seminary is affiliated to Western University.

In response to the recommendation of the Association of Theological Schools (ATS), the Strategic Plan identifies the governance structure under which it operates, the various partners who will be involved in its realization, and identifies specific Objectives and Action Tasks that will ensure the ongoing vitality of St. Peter's Seminary and its significant contribution to the formation of future pastoral leaders who will serve the Catholic Church in Canada. As outlined in its *Statement of Principles*, the Strategic Plan has been developed under the supervision of the Seminary Board of Shareholders, who will monitor the ongoing achievement of its Goals, Objectives and Action Tasks.

This Strategic Plan for St. Peter's Seminary was submitted to ATS May 1, 2015 and has been granted approval by the Association's Board of Accreditation. Our seminary community is energized about the ways this Strategic Plan provides intentional direction that will lead to growth in the ways our seminary's structures, programs and outreach can grow to even better serve the needs of the Church and World in bringing the message of Christ and his Kingdom to God's people.
